

Mitchel jousif/joseph (05May1794-TBA)

29 May 1794, Baptism register records Mitchell Joseph Jousif as the middle son of Francis and Caroline, St James, Picadilly.

Married 23 May 1816, Sarah Ann Prosser (24/11/1796-TBA) St Margarets Westminster. The marriage certificate is spelt MITCHEL JOSEPH appears to be a second name. Both adults are able to write their names. The certificate is signed by Elizabeth Prosser, Harriot Humphreys, Ann Sarah Prosser, Frances E Joseph(sister) and Eliza Joseph(sister). They had two children together,

5 may 1817 - Birth of Percy Robert Joseph, christened at St James, Westminster and father is a Wine Merchant. Sarah Ann is listed as parent on birth certificate.

15/05/1817, they are recorded as living on St James Street, Westminster.

Louisa Sarah Jousiff b 7 Nov 1818 in Middlesex.

She married Henry Needham Scrope Shrapnel on 19 Aug 1835 (I believe in Dover) She was 16 he was 23. They went on to have possibly 16 children (again I need to double check this) It looks like they moved to Canada somewhere between 1871 and 1873

Louisa died 26 Feb 1880 and was buried in Orrillia, Ontario, Canada.

I can't find any evidence (at the moment) that Mitchell was ever in Canada

26/04/1815 - Mitchell Joseph is recorded being a member of the Masonic lodge, Manchester and his profession is mariner. (I have clarified with a mason, that this is a profession and not a patrol).

1820,30 december-The London Gazette, Mitchell Joseph Jousiff of Princes Place, Middlesex of St James St, Pall Mall, Middlesex.....of Liverpool, Lancashire. Trade a Cheesemonger, formerly a wine merchant.

01/09/1821 Mitchel Joseph Jousif marries Sarah Georgina Casy, Islington and he is recorded as a widow on the marriage certificate. It is witnesses by William Henry?

16 June 1835 Mitchel Jousif, grocer in Birmingham, declared bankrupt.

17 Aug 1835, Louisa Sarah Jousiffe (1818-TBA) aged 17 marries Henry Needham Scrope Shrapnell 1835-TBA) at Canterbury, Kent. Father listed as Mich J Jousiff.

16 Jun 1835 Mitchell Jousiff a Grocer from Birmingham was declared bankrupt

then an article in the London Gazette dated 25 Jan 1839 states that a Bankruptcy order had been issued against Henry Squire Shrapnel of Birmingham and now or late of the University of Oxford and Mitchell Jousiff of Birmingham, Grocers, Dealers in Toys, Dealers and Chapmen (carrying on trade under the firm of Shrapnel and Company, unless they could show otherwise (ie not bankrupt before the 15 February 1839.

25 Jan 1839, London Gazette bankruptcy order issued against Henry Squire Shrapnel, Birmingham and the late Uni of Oxford and Mitchel Jousiffe, Birmingham.

1880,7 April - London evening standard. Josiffe - April 1, 6 Charlton Square SE. Sarah relic of Mitchell Jousiffe esq, Aged 78.

19/08/1891, Mitchel Joseph, 1 english male departs Liverpool for Philadelphia, USA.

1892- Mr M Joseph, 1 male departs Southampton to Alyoa Bay, South Africa. 1896- The same details and same route. Is this Mitchel?
